IMPORTANT SAFETY RULES TO FOLLOW

1. Inspect equipment before operating. Check for leaking fluid around jack.
2. Use on a flat, paved surface only.
3. Never overload equipment! Check rated load capacity on engine hoist. If you are unsure call the rental yard!!
4. Do not walk or stand under boom when raised.
5. Never position any part of your body under a suspended load. Keep hands clear of engine compartment when lifting and lowering engine.
6. Never work on an engine while it is suspended in air.
7. When lowering a load make sure to do it slowly.
8. Before towing run safety chain through winder handle, tighten hand tight only.
9. Hook safety chain to passenger side of vehicle.
10. Before towing: fasten hoist chain to loop at base of hoist and engage jack until all slack is removed from chain.

If the person receiving this handout will not be the user of the equipment, forward these instructions to the operator. If there is any doubt as to the operation or safety of the equipment,
